



## Additional Instructions / Teak

### Trace > Label > Cut & Fit > Ship It

You can pickup your own template materials at your local hardware store or purchase online @ [dugginsservices.com](http://dugginsservices.com). You will need a pattern material such as brown craft paper, or heavy 6mm plastic. Make sure the material will not stretch or crease. Pick up a marking pen and tape as well.

Make sure you have a straight edge and scissors handy.

**\*\*Special Note.** Teak patterns require additional steps before shipping.

## Instructions For Teak

- You only need to mark one (1) main center line through your entire piece. Please label this "MAIN LINE" Your other pieces must have lines as well, but will be oriented off the main line. Even if your pieces do not connect, we will need a straight, parallel line running through it.
- All lines must be parallel as we square pieces together. MARK ALL lines using a straight edge and permanent marker to achieve best results.
- If your pieces connect, mark on edges near each other as "A" and again on the adjoining piece "A". "B" to "B", so forth to all connecting pieces.
- Clear template material such as reinforced 6mm plastic, works best.
